PACKAGES

FIRST PACKAGE

100% SCHOLARSHIP on both tuition and accommodation. Additionally there is a stipend of at least \$200 monthly

NB: The student needs at least 90%-100% on their final exams to be eligible for this package.

STUDENT EXPENSES BEFORE GOING TO CHINA

- 1. \$200 application fee which is not fully refundable, only \$100 will be refundable if the student doesn't qualify.
- 2. Service and processing fee of \$700 which is paid after obtaining the acceptance letter.
- 3. Visa and ticket fee.



<u>SECOND PACKAGE</u>

100% SCHOLARSHIP on both tuition and accommodation.

NB: The student needs at least 90%-100% on their final exams to be eligible for this package.

STUDENT EXPENSES BEFORE GOING TO CHINA

- 1. \$200 application fee which is not fully refundable, only \$100 will be refundable if the student doesn't qualify.
- 2. Service and processing fee of \$700 which is paid after obtaining the acceptance letter
- 3. Visa and ticket fee.

THIRD PACKAGE

100% SCHOLARSHIP on tuition only.

NB: The student needs at least 80%-100% on their final exams to be eligible for this package.

STUDENT EXPENSES BEFORE GOING TO CHINA

- 1. \$200 application fee which is not fully refundable, only \$100 will be refundable if the student doesn't qualify.
- 2. Service and processing fee of \$500 which is paid after obtaining the acceptance letter
- 3. Visa and ticket fee



FOURTH PACKAGE

75% SCHOLARSHIP on tuition only. Education in China without scholarship is \$3500-\$6000. After the SpearEdu program it is reduced to at least \$400 per semester

NB:The student needs at least 75%-100% on their final exams to be eligible for this package.

STUDENT EXPENSES BEFORE GOING TO CHINA

- 1. \$200 application fee which is not fully refundable, only \$100 will be refundable if the student didn't qualify.
- 2. Service and processing fee of \$400 which is paid after obtaining the acceptance letter
- 3. Visa and ticket fee

LIVING EXPENSES IN CHINA

A student will need at least \$150 a month which is inclusive of food and rent

REQUIRED DOCUMENTS

- 1. Copy of passport(information page)
- 2. All high school transcripts and certificates
- 3. English proficiency or Certificate
- 4. Study or research plan not less than 200 words for undergraduate program

- 6. Medical Certificate/ foreigner physical examination form
- 7. Police clearance
- 8. CV
- 9. Passport photos
